The InterContinental Dubai Festival City

From meeting spaces that allow for a safe gathering, flexible terms and conditions that have been extended to mitigate investor risk, to touchless menus and contactless payment options - the AIBC Dubai expo will take place at The InterContinental Dubai Festival City.



Arrival and check-in - Entry requirements

All passengers arriving into Dubai from any point of origin (GCC countries included) must hold a negative COVID-19 PCR test certificate for a test taken no more than 72 hours before departure. UAE nationals are exempt, but will be required to take a COVID-19 PCR test at Dubai airport. Travellers must bring an official, printed certificate in English or Arabic to check in.



Hotel Check-in

Take advantage of new features such as self parking signage and external guides, touchless transactions and reduced contact and physical interaction at check-in. The hotel is also making use of front-desk screens, sanitiser stations and paperless checkouts. Staff have also been trained to increase disinfecting frequency and adhere to social distancing protocols.



Sanitising & cleaning protocols

All reception and concierge equipment will be frequently and consistently cleaned, sanitised, and disinfected. Hand sanitisers are available on all lift landing areas, while the lifts themselves feature social distancing signage.

Staff will wear masks, gloves, and shoe covers while servicing and cleaning guest rooms and public areas. Every guest room is disinfected after check-out using a Spray Cannon Fogging Machine with approved, safe chemicals. In addition room inspections are conducted to ensure high standards of cleanliness.



QR codes on menus

Precautionary signs will be posted at the restaurant entrance as per local law. Contactless menu with QR codes will be available on the tables.



Swimming Pool and Leisure Deck

Social distancing will include increased frequency of sanitising and disinfecting high-touch surfaces, sunbed sanitisation after each guest, sealed and sanitised towels, and Spray Cannon Fogging Machine usage during cleaning hours.



The Health Declaration Form

Individual forms are filled in by guests as an additional check-in procedure and subsequently attached to each corresponding registration card.



Meeting rooms & conference venues

We're redesigning our event space in accordance with evolving governmental and local venue guidelines. Meeting rooms will be scaled to size, with increased space between seating and attendees, and intentional directionally based traffic flow within the room.



Increased staff training

AIBC staff will be trained on standard operating procedures for maintaining social distancing and cleanliness, as part of the AIBC pandemic plan for 2021. All relevant PPEs are in stock and hotels are in full compliance with local and IHG guidelines. The safety of guests and colleagues remains our utmost priority.
